

The infrastructure of the college includes sixty two well furnished, spacious and airy classrooms including air conditioned rooms for MBACIT and computer science students. Various updated departmental labs of Home Science, Dress Designing & Office Management. Fully air conditioned computer labls consisting of 90 Core 2 duo computers with internet facility. Air conditioned seminar hall, well maintained staff rooms, centralized announcement system, Medical inspection Room, Gym, Photostat Facility, Recreation Room, Reading Room, Divinity Room also constitute part of healthy Infrastructure.

Psychology Lab

The Psychology Lab of this college consists of modern equipment like level of aspiration, judgement of facial expression, zeigarnik effect, to measure intelligence through verbal & tests, Macostra & Crae NEO big five personality inventory Interest inventory, Asthesiometer Maze learning apparatus mirror drawing apparatus, Muller Lyc illusion apparatus, MC Dougal Disc, Retroactive interference TAT Depression Inventory (Back) state trait. Anxiety inventory, self efficiency questionnaire Aggression scale, GSR biofeedback apparatus for the betterment of the students.

Fine Arts Lab

Fine Arts Lab is fully equipped with the latest equipments viz easels, drawing boards and pedestal lights. Well maintained Fine Arts Lab provides the most favourable environment for the students to develop their hidden talent.





Early Childhood Care & Education Lab

The college has a well-furnished and fully equipped early childhood care & education lab to impart practical knowledge of the subject.









College has spacious and hygienic cafeteria in the campus for the students to refresh themselves. This cafeteria offers well balanced and quality food at reasonable price.

Fashion Designing Labs

There are 3 Labs viz. Garment Construction Lab. Pattern Making Lab and Dyeing & Prininting Lab for the students of fashion designing. The garment construction lab is equipped with the latest automatic and semi automatic sewing machines, treadle machines, fashion makers, button fixing, buttonholing, lock stitch and over lock machines. The pattern making lab consists of three 4x8 and six 6x8 printing tables. The dyeing and printing lab includes block and screen printing material. There are computer systems equipped with the latest versions of designing softwares like Core Draw, Illustrator, Photoshop, CAD/CAM and Fashion Studio.



Campus Infrastructure

The college has four hi-tech Computer Labs equipped with 90 latest computers (core2duo with LCD Monitor) and three broadband internet connections to ensure accessibility for each student. The computer labs are equipped with adequate number of LCD Projectors and other peripherals.

Home Science Lab

The college has three well equipped Home Science Labs viz. Cooking Lab, Home Management Lab and Laundry & Textiles Lab. Each lab has working capacity of 30 students at a time. Labs are eqipped with modern instruments like microwave oven, cooking range, electrical gadgets, washing machine, sewing and embroidery machines etc.

Library & Reading Room

The Library is the soul of every educational institute and plays a significant role. College has a fully air-conditioned and computerized central library stocked with more than 40,000 latest text and reference books related to all disciplines of management, Arts, Computer, Commerce, Literature and many more. Library has an excellent collection of various National Level journals and magazines relating to different disciplines. There is a book bank facility available for needy students.



Seminar Hall

A spacious and air conditioned seminar hall accommodating 300 students with audio-visual aids and LCD projector facilities is available for the conduct of regular orientation programmes like extension lectures, guest lectures, workshops and personality development programmes.



Smart Class Room

Keeping with changing education scenario the college has established smart classes which is a major step towards meeting the modern infrastructure requirements. National Cadet Corps

Post Graduate Courses MBACIT (Master in Business Administration Commerce & Information Technology)

MBACIT is a two year full time programme, with an intake of 80 students. This course is spread over four semesters. During the first two semesters, core and foundation subjects are offered. These include Management Concepts and Approaches, Finance, Marketing, Human Resource Management, Quantitative Techniques, Economics, Information Technology, Communication and Personal effectiveness. A weekly workshop is organised to support intellectual engagement and connectedness to the wider world.



Scholarship Schemes

1. SC/ST/BC Students

The SC/ST students whose parents/guardians have annual income not exceeding Rs 2.5 Lakh shall be eligible for Post Metric Scholarship Schemes to Scheduled Caste Students, Studies in India Non Plan Centrally Sponsored Scheme. The BC students whose parents/guardians have annual income not exceeding Rs 1 Lakh shall be eligible for Post Metric Scholarship Schemes to Backward Classes Students, Studies in India Non Plan Centrally Sponsored Scheme.

Important Notes

- 1. The affidavit regarding income submitted by student's father or guardian must be in original and attested by executive magistrate.
- 2. A student already getting a scholarship under any other scheme can not avail scholarship under this scheme.

College Rules

As said by scholars and achievers that discipline is the key to success. Here in Master Tara Singh Memorial College for Women we also feel the same. Following are some rules which each and every student has to adhere:

- Any student found guilty of ragging would be suspended from the college.
- On every Monday and all academic functions, all students are required to be in college uniform viz white suit with white dupatta in summer, white suit with black cardigan in winter. Students not in proper uniform will be fined.
- □ As the college authorities issue identity card at the commencement of the session, every student is required to carry her respective identity card during her stay in college campus.
- □ Leave for absence from the college should be applied personally by a student on the prescribed form available in the college office. In case of illness the application should be supported by medical certificate. Absence from any lecture shall be fined. Absentees shall be reported daily and the name shall be stuck off after seven consecutive days of absence and student will have to seek re-admission.
- ☐ Students can change their subject within 15 days from the commencement of classes on the

- prescribed performa available from the office.
- □ A student who loses, defaces or damages college library books shall have to pay the full cost.
- □ Every student must attend 75% of lectures delivered both in theory and practicals.
 Otherwise she will be detained from appearing in the university examinations.
- □ No student will be allowed to leave the college before the 7th period without the permission of Principal/Tutor.
- Students caught bunking classes shall be fined Rs. 50/- on the spot.
- ☐ In case of change Address/Tel. No., students should inform the college office immediately.
- ☐ Use of mobile phones are strictly prohibited in college campus and shall be confiscated from students.
- ☐ Students are not allowed to bring any valuable article to the college campus.
- ☐ All rules and regulations prescribed by Panjab University, Chandigarh are applicable to the College students.
- □ Parents can visit Principal Office between 11 am to 1 pm during working days.
